

Children's COVID-19 Vaccination Appointments – Children's Outpatient Department, North Hospital We are offering the following Children's COVID Vaccination Clinics for Ages 5-11, Ages 12-15 and Ages 16-17 in the Children's Outpatients Department, North Hospital, St Mary's (NOT the Hospital Vaccine Hub). Appointments must be booked in advance, we are unable to offer walk-ins. After the 15 December the NBS booking system will not be available until the Spring and so **please book appointments by calling 0300 561 0018**

- they have an immunosuppressed disorder
- or have close family contact with someone who has an immunosuppressed disorder
- or have not had any COVID vaccination in the past.

All vaccines offered will be the Pfizer XBB.1.5 vaccines.
